Update on Bibi: We have been in contact with Bibi, who runs the orphanage in Bamako, Mali, West Africa. As we have her in our prayers following her diagnosis of breast cancer, she sent this letter at Redeemer's Bibi's Hope Committee request.

I hope this message finds you well. I wanted to share some updates with you regarding my health. We traveled to Dubai for this health situation. We saw the doctor, and he explained to us the exact same information Steph (Schutte) told us. He gave us different options for the treatment and how long it would take with each treatment.

The final decision was to do the surgery first then treatment because at the end of the day, the outcome will be surgery, so I decided to trust the doctor, and the surgery was scheduled for this Saturday (July 6). I am hopeful.

As you all know, this journey involves several aspects beyond the surgery itself. There are medical expenses, including consultations, tests, prescriptions and the surgery itself. Additionally, there are ongoing costs such as medications and follow-up appointments after the surgery.

Beyond medical expenses, there are practical considerations like visa renewals, everyday necessities like food and rent in Dubai, and other foreseen expenses, such as radiation/chemotherapy.

Your willingness to help and support means the world to me during this time. My daughter Tina is doing the best to help as much as she can. Estimated expenses so far are \$15,000 up to the surgery. Here's an update about the expenses we're facing in Dubai:
