### <u>IDW – VOLUNTEER LERT Team Site Supervisor Job Description</u> (Spencer flooding – August ~ September) **Responsibilities**:

Personnel Management: Manage volunteer LERT team members, assign tasks, and monitor performance; Safety and Security: Implement safety procedures and address any hazards promptly; Collaboration: Communicate with city disaster coordinators to build working relationships and awareness of community permit needs and restrictions; Policy Implementation: Implement LERT policies and procedures;

Equipment Maintenance: Maintain needed equipment (or be in contact with LERT trailer steward congregations); Ordering site materials: some PPE, drywall materials, etc.

Requirements: Certifications: basic LERT trained (or willing to be trained); Experience: familiar with basic power washing, sanitizing, and framing/drywall (will be given specific product information when needed); LERT does not do plumbing, electrical, or HVAC work; Skills: Strong leadership, communication, and problem-solving skills. Understand that we do this work to reach out with Christ's love and hope; Tech Savvy: Willing to learn Zuper app, site management system used by LERT.
