Call to Worship

I have not let His love have its way with me, and so my love for others has failed. There are those whom I have hurt, and those whom I failed to help. - O Almighty God, merciful Father, I, a poor miserable sinner confess to you all my sins with which I have ever offended you and deserved your punishment now and forever. But I am sincerely sorry for them, and I pray you, for the sake of your beloved Son, Jesus Christ to be merciful to me.
- Do you believe that the word of Christ's forgiveness I speak to you is from the Lord Himself?
- C Yes, I do.
- Receive the forgiveness Jesus won for you by His passion, death, and resurrection. By His command, I, a called and ordained servant of the Word, forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. C Amen.

- **G** I will see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living.
- P Wait for the Lord;
- **G** be strong and take heart and wait of the Lord.
