Opening ... "The Advent of Our King" LSB 331 vrs. 1-3, 6

Invocation and Lighting of the Advent Wreath

P: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen. (One blue candle is lit on the Advent wreath.)

P: The name of the city of David, the little town of Bethlehem, means "House of Bread." It was the birthplace for Jesus our Savior, who called himself the Bread of Life. We light the first candle on our Advent wreath remembering that Jesus, the living Bread from heaven, came to offer himself as the perfect sacrifice for our sins.

C: Jesus, Bread of heaven, feed us now and forever.

Confession and Absolution

- P: Through the prophet Isaiah, the Lord asks us, "Why do you spend your money for that which is not bread, and your labor for that which does not satisfy?" (Isaiah 55:2). We turn away from God's will to things that can never satisfy us. Let us confess our sins to God and ask his forgiveness.
- C: Almighty God, we have turned away from your Word and your will for our lives. We try to satisfy our needs by following the temptations of the devil, the world around us and our own sinful desires. Have mercy on us and forgive our sins.
- P: God has had mercy on us. He sent his Son into the world to be our Savior and, for his sake, forgives our sins. God tells us, "Listen diligently to me, and eat what is good, and delight yourselves in rich food. Incline your ear, and come to me; hear, that your soul may live" (Isaiah 55:2-3). I announce to you that your sins are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

C: Jesus, Bread of heaven, feed us now and forever!
